

## PROGRAM PURPOSE

The intent of the Ti-180 program is to provide early intervention for substance use, increase resiliency, provide parents with education regarding signs and symptoms of substance use, and to identify those youth who could benefit from a behavioral health assessment based on the results of the screening tools that are administered prior to the program, as well as, urine drug screen results.

Ti-180 is collaboration between the Medina County Juvenile Court, Honorable Kevin W. Dunn, Medina County Juvenile and Probate Judge and Alternative Paths, Inc.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## Who is it for?

In general, the Ti-180 is a program for first time offenders who have an alcohol or other drug related charge.

## What is it?

The youth and at least one parent/guardian participate together in a one-time three and half hour session that is facilitated by a licensed clinician from Alternative Paths, Inc. The intent of the program is to provide early intervention for substance abuse, increase resiliency, provide parents with education about the warning signs of substance abuse, and to identify those youth who could benefit from a substance abuse and/or mental health assessment based on the results of screening tools (written questionnaires) administered prior to the program.

## Where is it held?

Ti-180 takes place at the Juvenile Court Annex Building located at 755 Independence Drive, Medina, Ohio 44256. **Please note:** This location is **NOT** the Courthouse on the Medina Square.

## When does Ti-180 take place?

Ti-180 sessions are typically scheduled one Saturday per month, every other month. Families will find the date of the session they have been assigned to on the Pre-dispositional Order provided by the clerk. The session starts at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 12:30 p.m.
